GROUP QUESTIONS

MICAH 4:8 to 5:15

What struck, challenged or encouraged you in God's word, or the teaching on Sunday?

Jesus, Son of God, is faithful to his promises of judgement and rescue. Will we truly come under him, the Shepherd King?

God judges and disperses his people (4:8 to 5:1)

Have a look through these verses (and the next set, up to verse 6). How many of these prophecies do we now see have taken place? How does this help us understand God and his promises?

The Shepherd King rescues and gathers his people (5:2-5:6)

To the people of God in 700BC these verses describe the means of their rescue - how does Jesus fulfil this description (try and remember which Bible verses support this)? Again, how does this help us understand Christ and his promise?

What are God's people like under the Shepherd king? (5:7 - 5:15)

Jesus uses his church as a means of refreshment to the peoples around us - through the Good news of Jesus (v7) but also as a means of showing God's verdict on the world (v8). v10 onward also show how God's people are being reformed. How is our church today fulfilling the role to others around us like this? In what parts of our lives (particularly money, time and relationships) is the Lord reforming us so that our lives are guided fully by our Shepherd King, Jesus?
