3 October. Ephesians 2:8-10.

What struck, challenged or encouraged you from God's word on Sunday?

Ephesians 2:8-10 begins to ask the question: how does the grace I receive connect with the work that I do?

We are completely saved by God's grace (8-9)

Why does Paul restate the phrase "it is by grace you have been saved" in v8 after having already said it in v5? How have we been saved?

Do you ever feel as though you need to earn God's grace (his unmerited favour)? How do we counteract this?

We are completely saved for God's work (10)

What does it mean for you to be God's handiwork?

If we're 'created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do'? What good works does that mean for us?

How then can we please God, if our salvation (and many other things) come to us only by grace, through faith?

In your Growth Group, what one thing can others pray for each one of you in applying this part of God's word to your life?
